Physician Assistant (PA) Student Involvement on Clinical Rotations

Supervising physicians will be members of the MCH Medical Staff.

P.A. student involvement on clinical rotations will be under the preceptorship of the supervising physician.

P.A. Students are not licensed and therefore are not permitted to practice medicine, but are in an education program accredited by the Accreditation Review Commission on Education for the Physician Assistant of the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs.

P.A. Students will be participating in patient care activities; but only under the direction and guidance of their supervising physician and as appropriate the staff of MCH.

P.A. Students are permitted to dictate and / or document H&P, Progress Notes, Discharge Summaries and write orders in the patient medical record.

The supervising physician is responsible for any services provided and cosigning all entries and dictation(s) of the P.A. Student.

Supervising physicians will comply with all MCH policy/ies.
